- Changing Buttons for a New Look

A quick and easy way to restyle a garment is to change the buttons. First, check the style of button:

- **Shank**
- **2-Hole**
- **4-Hole**

When looking for a new button, be sure to choose the same style and size as the original. Other than that, the creative options are endless!

### Steps:

1. Remove the original button with a seam ripper.
2. Thread the needle with a double thread about 18 inches long.
3. Start by hiding the knot within the facing or hem allowance.
4. Sew the button on with at least three loops of thread.
5. Knot the thread and hide the thread tail within the facing or hem allowance.
