Supplies Needed:

- Any Jacket Pattern
- Hidden Zipper
- Fusible Interfacing – 2" wide by length of new seam
- Pocket Lining
- Pattern drafting supplies:
  - Sharpie, Scissors, Tape, Ruler, Extra Paper,

Adding a hidden pocket is easy to do with any jacket pattern. I use these pockets for lip-gloss, money, sunglass wipes, you name it!

### Re-Designing a Pattern for Pockets:

- Start by determining where on the jacket you want the pocket, the location does not have to be on a seam either.
- Draw a line on the pattern creating a seam line. Be sure to add markings to add ½” seam allowances to each side of this new seam.
- Press fusible interfacing for each side of the seam by 2” wide.



- **Pocket lining:** Draw in the pocket lining, starting at the new line on the pattern. The depth of the pocket can be anything you want, most of mine are around 4” deep. Make sure the pocket extends at least 2” past each side of the zipper. Trace pattern and add ½” seam allowances.
