HEMMING SLINKY OR OTHER KNITS

To put in a hem with no trouble and have it look right every time, machine baste (5.0) SewkeysE Extremely Fine 1/2 inch Knit Stay Tape or One Inch Knit Interfacing Tape onto the wrong side of the fabric with the fuse side up. Once the tape is basted on to the wrong side of the fabric, you can do one of two things.

1. Take your hem to a four thread serger clean finish the edge and press up the hem. The fusible stay tape will hold your hem in place so you can top stitch with a single or double needle.
2. Once the tape is basted into place, press up the hem and take your hem to your cover stitch and stitch in place.
