- Princess Seams

Princess seams are a not only a design feature in many dresses, but they also offer easy solutions for fitting.

Princess seams can end at the shoulder or armhole.

When sewing princess seams, make sure to feed the fabric through the sewing machine evenly so you don't end up with puckers in the full bust area.

If the dress is unlined (like the beige dress above), one idea is to finish the seam edges by serging, press the seam allowance toward the center of the body, and topstitch in place.

If the dress is lined:

Clip the curve of the bust area as shown and press the seam open. Press the curve of the seam on a [pressing ham](#).

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
