

Season 600 - The Little Black Dress

- Alter Neckline Curve and Add Facing

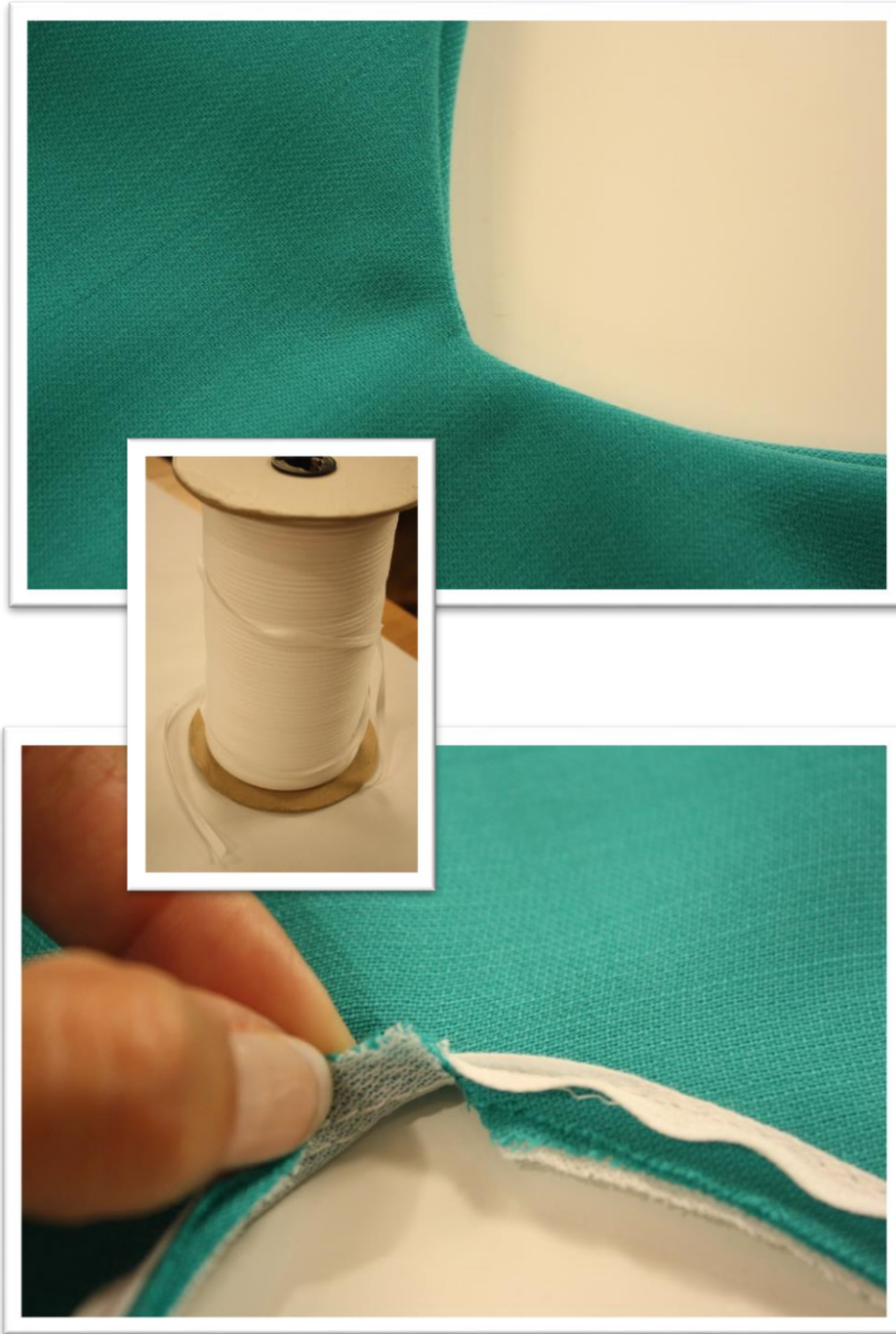
Fabric: All the fabrics I use on *It's Sew Easy TV* come from [Vogue Fabrics Patterns and Sewing Supplies](#): [The Angela Wolf Pattern Collection](#)



Here is an easy trick for a perfect neckline regardless of the shape:

[1/4" wide cotton twill tape](#)

- Take the fashion fabric and facing, with right sides together, stitch the neckline.
- Add a piece of twill tape, following the same stitch line. Slightly pull the twill tape while stitching.
- For a v-neck, snip into the point of the V (snip all the way to the stitch line, but not through the stitch line).
- Press the seam open and flip the facing over.





It's very easy to alter a pattern neckline. Starting with the original neckline curve, draw a new curve or v-neck. It's easiest to start at the original shoulder seam.

Alter the facing piece to match the new neckline or simply draw a new facing piece on the center front piece and the side front piece.
