## Season 600 - The Little Black Dress

• Hemming the Vent

Fabric: All the fabrics I use on It's Sew Easy TV come from Vogue Fabrics Patterns and Sewing Supplies: The Angela Wolf Pattern Collection







- Attach a fusible interfacing to each side of the vent (as shown to the left)
- Press up the hem and make sure the hemlines align.



Fold back the vent and press – you are left with the under flap (which lays flat) and the inside flap (which is pressed back)



- Under flap:
  - o flip the fabric back along the hemline
  - o with right sides together, stich the edge of the hemline
  - o turn fabric to the right side of the garment and press.























Tailor's Clapper

- Inside flap:
  - o Sew a metered edge for a professional finish.
  - o Fold the fabric with right side together and stitch on an angle form the hemline to the edge of the vent.
  - o Turn the corner right side out.
  - Press.
