



## It's Sew Easy 705-1

### Embroidered Tote with Kaleidoscope Design

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#### Materials

- PC (or a Windows emulator - such as Parallels or VMware Fusion - running on a Mac)
- *Kaleidoscope Collections'* Kaleidoscope Kreator 3\*
- *Kaleidoscope Collections'* Filigrees Template Pack for Kaleidoscope Kreator 3\*
- *Kaleidoscope Collections'* Filigrees Embroidery Collection\*

#### Instructions

The instructions for creating a filigree kaleidoscope design, printing it onto fabric and lining up the embroidery with the printed design are all included in the Filigrees Embroidery Collection. (*Please note:* The border design around the embroidered filigree is a custom design and not part of the Filigrees Embroidery Collection. The border can be filled with any free-motion or embroidered design or simply left plain to highlight the embroidered filigree even more.)

To fit an 8" filigree embroidery block with a 2" border around it, you will need to modify the pattern:

- increase the width of the bag body by 1 inch total (i.e. 1/2" increase on the pattern piece since it is placed on a fold)
- increase the height of the bag body by 1 inch
